# 2025 Schools Admissions

- Apply on-line, apply on-time.
  - Name 5 preferences for a secondary school application.
  - Name 3 preferences for a primary school application.
  - Include your most local school.
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- If your child is starting Secondary School in September 2025 you must apply on-line between 2 September 2024 and 31 October 2024.
  - If your child is moving from Infant to Junior School in September 2025 you must apply on-line between 4 November 2024 and 15 January 2025.
  - If your child is starting Primary School (Reception) in September 2025 you must apply on-line between 4 November 2024 and 15 January 2025 (for children born between 1 September 2020 and 31 August 2021).
