Literacy

Our theme is 'One wonderful world'

We will be looking at both fiction and non-fiction books about different environments and landscapes.

We will be focusing on:

- Discussing different cultures and ways of life, thinking about the similarities and differences we all share.
- The children will increase their knowledge of people, communities and environments from around the world.

**Phonics** 

We are reading.

Winter Garden

We will continue with our Little Wandle phonics daily program.

The sounds we are learning this half term are: ai, ee, igh, oa, oo, "oo", ar, or, ur, ow, oi, ear, air, er, bb, pp, ff, tt.

Reading is an integral part of your child's learning and reading stories to your child helps them increase their vocabulary, imagination and helps them to make sense of the world around them.

Reminder: Book bags are sent home on a Monday and need to be returned to school on Friday, with the school reading book and reading record.

Could you please write in their record book to show that you have heard them read.

Maths

We are learning. to:

- Subitise and recognise small amounts of objects without counting them.
- We will continue to look at how numbers are made up and their different compositions and arrangements.
- We will be looking at the ordinality and cardinality of numbers.

Knowledge and Understanding of the World

We will be learning about:

- Different cultures.
- How we can save animals.
- How to make pictures using different media.
- Changes that happen to materials over time e.g. ice, trees and the seasons.
